First language Lab in state inaugurated at DBYC

ITANAGAR, June 21: Western Parliamentary constituency MP Takam Sanjoy said that the Defense Minister A K Antony has accepted the demand for formation of Arunachal Scout with energetic and courageous Arunachalee youths for security of this sensitive border state.
